



## Prechtl's Method of the Qualitative Assessment of General Movements ADVANCED Course

### Course Aims

This 3.5-day course is for participants who are already engaged in applying Prechtl's Method on the Qualitative Assessment of General Movements.

The Advanced Course will provide additional intensive training in correct judgement, with the details of the assessment, the proper terminology and technique, as well as with the application of individual developmental trajectories.

Main topics of lectures, demonstrations and exercises:

- Assessment of components of GMs in term and preterm infants
- Evaluation of individual GMs trajectories
- Assessment of fidgety movements and motor repertoire in 3-5 month old infants
- Discussion of diagnosis based on the participant's practice

### Pre-requisites

Participants registering for the Advanced course **must have previously completed the GMA Basic Training course.**
